

We are located in cosy cities with a good balance between social life and studying. Depending on your programme choice, you will be studying in one of these cities.



Enschede

Enschede is a pleasant city to build up your new student life. The city has a vibrant centre and has nature nearby. The international student community is big, giving you the opportunity to make international friends for a lifetime! The campus in Enschede is the first real 'City Campus' in the Netherlands. It doesn't look like a traditional school at all, but you can feel the campus atmosphere with different pavilions for our different study programmes. The campus is a 5 minutes' walk from the city town, so after class, you can easily find a study spot in the centre or have a drink with friends.



Deventer

Deventer has a historic city full of charm, with all the necessary shops, bars and restaurants and nature nearby. The Saxion campus in Deventer is located in the centre and within walking distance from the train station. The striking architecture, designed by the Dutch architect Paul Dirks and the special location, a few minutes from the old town, the city centre and the arts centre, are all ingredients that make this an exceptional learning environment.



Apeldoorn

Compared to other Dutch cities, Apeldoorn is surprisingly different. It offers a peacefulness with its extensive woods surrounding the city combined with a city centre full of bars, restaurants and shops. Apeldoorn houses Saxion's smallest campus. This modern building is located in the city centre, conveniently next to the train station. The catering of the campus is partly provided by Hotel Management students to practice, creating an international gastronomy feeling. The students also have their own wine bar, where they learn all the ins and outs about winetasting and dining.




General entry requirements

- You must be admissible to Higher Education through a diploma of secondary education/high school diploma.
- You must have sufficient English language skills for the specific course, usually IELTS with a minimum score of
 6.0 (check other certificates on our website).
