

Immigration Procedure for Non-EU students

Except for Australia, Canada, Japan, Monaco, New Zealand, South Korea, USA, Vatican City, Nepal, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Iran, North-Korea, Cuba, Syria and exchange students.

You need an entry visa (MVV) and a residence permit (VVR) for the purpose of study. Saxion will process your visa application after receiving payment of your total package fee and the required visa documents.

In order for Saxion to apply for your visa you need to submit –before the deadline– the following:

- Payment of the total package fee including:
housing (if applicable), visa, insurance and proof of financial means.
- Immigration Application Form
- Appendix Antecedents Certificate
- A clear copy of your valid passport (the personal data page + all stamped pages)
- Chinese students only: Original NUFFIC certificate

Payment total package fee

See payment details in the invoice you receive from Saxion after you did receive your admission (under condition).

Upload required documents

You need to upload these in our application portal <https://sis.saxion.nl>:

- Immigration Application Form
- Appendix Antecedents Certificate
- A clear copy of your valid passport
- Chinese students only: Original NUFFIC certificate

Important notes

- Without the above documents and payment, Saxion cannot apply for your visa and residence permit.
- Saxion International Office acts as an intermediary and has no influence whatsoever on the outcome or duration of the application process. If the submitted documents do not meet the requirements, you may be asked to prove your financial means in a different manner.
- We strongly recommend no travel plans are made or costs are incurred until a decision regarding your visa application is made and the visa has been issued by the Dutch embassy.

Information Proof of Financial Means

Throughout the visa application procedure, Saxion will send all paperwork to the Dutch Immigration Service (IND). For this process we also need proof that you have sufficient financial means to pay for the relevant costs and support yourself during your entire study period in The Netherlands. The payment of the tuition fee is not sufficient to prove your financial means.

How to pay and how much do you need to prove?

Important notes

- You will receive a refund after your arrival in the Netherlands and after you have a Dutch bank account.
- It will take approximately 2–3 weeks to have the amount of the financial means transferred to your Dutch bank account after arrival in the Netherlands, so please make sure you have sufficient funds in the meantime to pay for food, supplies etc.

Who should complete this appendix?

Pursuant to Articles 3.77, paragraph 11 and 3.86, paragraph 18 of the Aliens Decree, every foreign national aged 12 years or older must complete this appendix.

Please note! This statement consists of 2 pages. You must complete **both** pages.

1 Declaration of the foreign national

On this form you fill in whether you have ever committed a crime or a criminal offence. These are crimes committed in the Netherlands and criminal offences committed outside the Netherlands. You must answer the questions with *Yes* or *No*. Not completing the form truthfully or failing to report is a criminal offence. This can lead to a sanction. Your answers may have consequences for your application or for a residence permit that you have previously received.

Processing of personal data

The Immigration and Naturalisation Service (IND) processes personal data when it processes your application, notification, or request. This means that if needed the IND will request data from you yourself and other organisations or persons. The IND also uses and stores data and shares them with other organisations. When doing so, the IND strictly adheres to the stipulations of privacy legislation. For instance, the IND must treat data safely and with due care. The law also gives rights. At your request, you are allowed to see which data on you the IND processes. You can also get information on why the IND does so and to whom your data have been passed on.
