

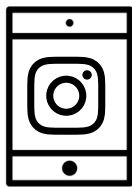

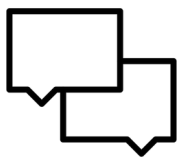

ARRIVAL CHECKLIST

Moving to another country can be an overwhelming experience, so it's a good idea to be well prepared. Below you can see our basic checklist to get you started.

HIGH PRIORITY UPON ARRIVAL

- BSN- registration at the city hall (BSN = mandatory Dutch citizen number. More info via email)
- Pick-up residence permit: (only for non-EU students)
- Undergo tuberculosis check (only for specific nationalities. More info via email)

OTHER IMPORTANT MATTERS

- Opening a Dutch bank account
- Get your DigiD (BSN is required)
- Register with a general practitioner and dentist

SETTLING IN

- Getting around Saxion
- Join a study or student association

3. TUBERCULOSIS SCREENING

Non-EU students with specific nationalities who need a residence permit based on study, must be checked on TB (Tuberculosis) after arrival. You will receive the first invite from the International Office via e-mail. The costs for the TB-check will not be covered by your insurance.

At a TB check-up, an X-ray will be made of the lungs, or a skin test will be performed (only for minors). In case there are some doubts, the student is asked to come again for an extra check-up or possible treatment. Please note that only the extra check-up or treatment is covered by the health insurance Saxion arranges for international NON-EU students.

1. BSN-REGISTRATION

If you move to the Netherlands from abroad, you must register as a resident here. After registering you will receive a Dutch citizen service number (BSN). You need a BSN for the following things:

- To open a Dutch bank account
- To work
- To take out healthcare insurance
- To apply for governmental benefits

An appointment will be arranged for students who will reside in Enschede or Deventer. You will receive an email from International Office with an invitation for the registration.

Students who live in another city have to schedule an appointment by themselves.

2. PICK-UP RESIDENCE PERMIT

After Saxion applied for your residence permit, you will receive an email that it has been approved. In case you have to go to the IND to let your biometrics be taken, you will be informed on how to do so by the International Office.

Once your residence permit is ready to be picked up, you will also receive an email from International Office.



OTHER IMPORTANT MATTERS

4. OPENING A DUTCH BANK ACCOUNT

There are many different banks which offer a variety of services. You can choose one of them for opening a bank account and other financial matters.

What do I need to bring to the bank?

- BSN number
- Certificate of enrolment (you can get this at Servicepoint or send an email to servicepoint@saxion.nl)
- Valid passport / ID

Refund proof of financial means (non-EU only)

The refund of the financial means will be done to a Dutch bank account.

- Once you have a BSN number and a Dutch bank account, the refund can be requested via Osiris.
- You will be contacted about this process by International Office.

6. REGISTER WITH A GENERAL PRACTITIONER / DENTIST

In the Netherlands, you need to see the family doctor (general practitioner) first before you can get a referral for a specialist in the hospital.

5. GET YOUR DIGID

Apply for a DigiD account. It is necessary for you to have a DigiD Account. This is the official Dutch governmental way to identify yourself. It can help you with official procedures during your time in the Netherlands and at Saxion.

DigiD can help you for example with:

- Studielink.nl
- Part time jobs
- Belastingdienst = taxes

To apply for DigiD you need to have your BSN. You can apply for the DigiD account via this [link](#).

MEDICAL CARE

Medical care is of high quality in the Netherlands. Since medical costs for treatment can be very high, it is very important to be properly insured, especially if you need specialist help from the hospital. In the Netherlands you need to see the Family doctor/GP first before you can go to the Hospital.

INSURANCE

As a non-EU students you will have to arrange insurance when living in the Netherlands. Saxion can facilitate this for you by applying for a student insurance via AON. This amount will be automatically added to your invoice. You will be insured for your first year. For the following study year(s), students must arrange their own health insurance.

Once you start with a part-time job you need to take out the basic Dutch health insurance.

Are you an EU student? Check in your home country what your insured for and if this covers your stay in the Netherlands. You can check EHIC (European Health Insurance Card), which only covers necessary health care. You could consider taking out additional insurance.

Medical costs in The Netherlands can be very high if not properly insured.

FIRST AID (EHBO)

In case of an emergency, you can get help 24 hours a day at the local hospital:

- Follow the signs 'Spoedpost' = emergency room
- Always make an appointment before you go. First-Aid Visit [this page](#) to make a phone call: +31 (0)570 - 501 777
- Weekdays after 5 pm and in the weekends.
- Only in case of emergency.

- Family doctor services Twente Oost, Beltstraat 70 in Enschede
- Close to the Hospital - Medisch Spectrum Twente.
- Always make an appointment before you go. First-Aid +31 (0)88-5551188.
- Weekdays after 5 pm and in the weekends.
- Only in case of emergency.

Apeldoorn

- Gelre Apeldoorn at Albert Schweitzerlaan 31, 7334 DZ Apeldoorn
- Always make an appointment before you go. First-Aid +31 (0)88 - 105 3300
- Weekdays after 5 pm and in the weekends.
- Only in case of emergency.

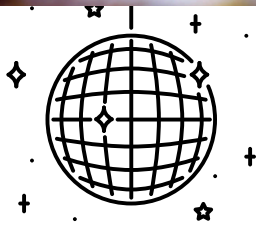

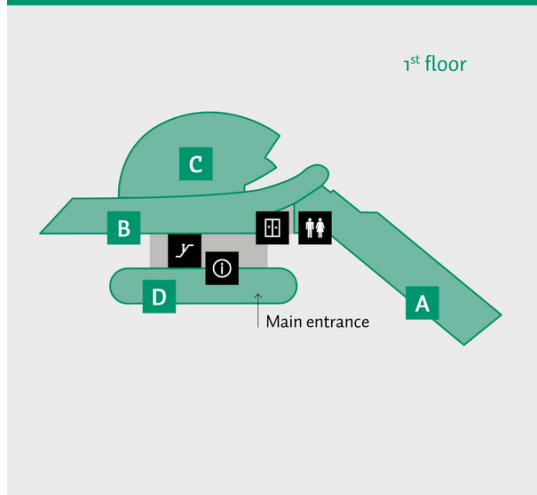
GETTING AROUND SAXION

Floorplan Deventer

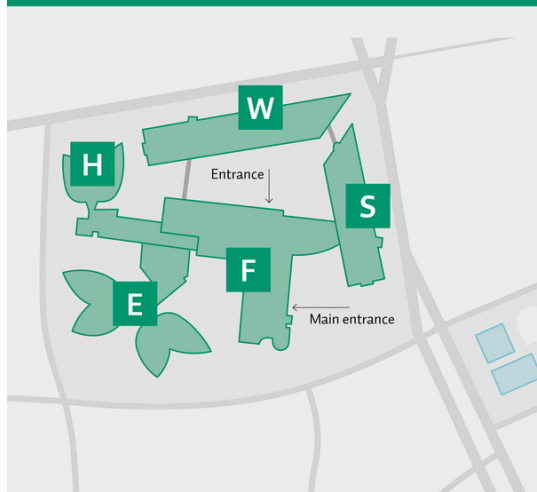

About 10% of Saxion students have a disability or learning difficulty. Examples include dyslexia, dyscalculia, AD(H)D, autism, a visual or hearing impairment, stuttering or a chronic (mental) illness.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

For many internationals arriving in the Netherlands, Dutch transportation means one thing: the bicycle. But while the Dutch have created the best cycling infrastructure in the world, they've done some great things with their public transit system, too. So whether you're looking to take a train to Tilburg or a bus to Bloemendaal, it's easy getting around the country.

THE OV-CHIPCARD

The OV-chipcard is the payment method for public transport in the Netherlands. If you carry an OV-chipcard with you, you no longer need to think about strip tickets or bus tickets. You load credit onto the OV-card in Euro or add a travel product, such as a single journey, a monthly pass for commuting or a season ticket.

Yes, you can pay for public transport in the Netherlands using a contactless bank card (debit card) or a mobile device with a contactless payment system (like Apple Pay or Google Wallet). This is called OVpay.

LET'S MEET EACH OTHER: GOIN' APP

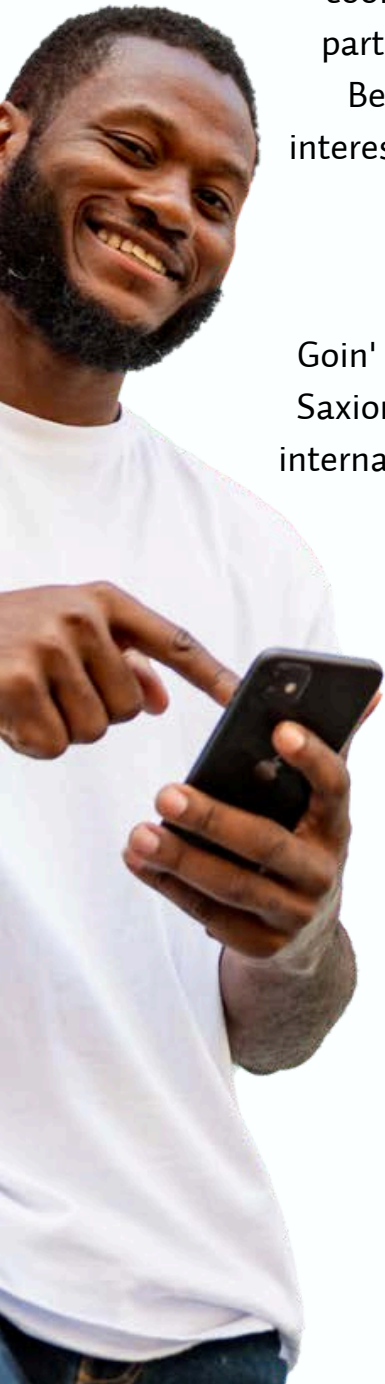
The app Goin' is a social platform for students at Saxion. This is where you come in contact with other (international) students from the Saxion community.
