Holland Scholarship (HS)

This scholarship is meant for excellent and very talented students from outside the European Economic Area (EEA) who want to follow their bachelor's or master's degree in the Netherlands.

Amount	Euro 5,000
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> » Your nationality is non-EU/EEA and you pay full institutional tuition fee; » You apply for a full-time bachelor's or master's programme at Saxion University of Applied Sciences as a new student; » You meet the specific requirements of the study programme of your choice; » You have not studied at one of the Dutch institutions in the past; » You do not receive any other scholarship for the same study year and study programme.

Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> » GPA 7,5 or higher based on the grade list you use to enroll at Saxion; » IELTS 6,5 or higher (or the equivalent of IELTS). »
How to Apply	<p>Bachelor programmes: Submit the scholarship application form between 1 January and 15 April</p> <p>Master programmes: Submit the scholarship application form between 1 January and 1 May</p>
Selection procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> » The Saxion Scholarship committee will assess all complete and eligible applications; » A ranking of the candidates will be made for the purpose of the selection; » A limited number of scholarships is available; » The result will be announced by email within 30 days after the deadline.

Saxion Talent Scholarship (STS)

This scholarship is meant for talented students who apply for a bachelor programme with above average study results.

Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none">» Your nationality is non-EU/EEA and you pay full institutional tuition fee;» You apply for a full-time bachelor's at Saxion University of Applied Sciences as a new student;» You meet the specific requirements of the study programme of your choice;» You do not receive any other scholarship for the same study year and study programme;
Qualifying Programmes	(all) Bachelor programmes
Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">» GPA higher than average based on the grade list you use to enrol at Saxion;» IELTS 6,0 or higher (or the equivalent of IELTS).
How to Apply	Submit the scholarship application form between 1 January and 15 April
Selection procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none">» The Saxion Scholarship committee will assess all complete and eligible applications;» A ranking of the candidates will be made for the purpose of the selection;» A limited number of scholarships is available;» The result will be announced by email within 30 days after the deadline.

Orange Tulip Scholarship (OTS)

Saxion University of Applied Sciences (UAS) offers the OTS to bachelor candidates from Brazil, China, Indonesia, Korea, Mexico, Russia, Vietnam, South Africa, India, as a waiver.

Amount	Euro 3,900
Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none">» You must be a candidate with a nationality of the eligible country;» You apply for a full-time bachelor's programme at Saxion UAS as a new student;» You meet the specific requirements of the study programme of your choice;» You do not receive any other scholarship for the same study year and study programme;» You pay full institutional tuition fee.

Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">» GPA 7,5 or higher based on the grade list you use to enrol at Saxion;» IELTS 6,5 or higher (or the equivalent of IELTS);» Check also the information about the OTS of the NESO office of your country.
How to Apply	Submit your application via the NESO website of your country
Selection procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none">» The NESO offices will send the nomination to Saxion;» Saxion will assess the nomination and send the final result to NESO offices;» The NESO offices will issue the result.» Saxion is offering 2 scholarships for one academic year to each participating country.

Saxion Excellent Scholarship (SES)

The SES is a scholarship for Saxion students who have passed the first year of their bachelor programme and would like to continue studying in the next study year (2nd, 3rd or 4th year) at Saxion UAS.

Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none">» Your nationality is non-EU/EEA and you pay full institutional tuition fee;» You take part in a Saxion bachelor programme.» You continue your study programme at Saxion (2nd, 3rd, 4th year).
Qualifying Programmes	(all) Bachelor programmes
Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">» ECTS of 90% or higher
How to Apply	Submit the scholarship application form between 1 June and 30 September
Selection procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none">» Saxion will check the students re-registration and transcript of records in Bison.
