



SPORTKEUR 2.0: THEME DASHBOARDS FOR SPORT RISKS

Practicing sports involves certain risks. Within the Sportkeur 2.0 project, these risks are mapped out with various stakeholders (sports associations, government, athletes, sports clubs, accommodation owners, manufacturers of sports equipment) using: apps for mobile phones and tablets and made available within these apps and a web application so that proper action can be taken.

The company that developed the software, Go2Sure, brainstormed together with the municipality of Enschede 10 risk themes: social, athlete, organization, spectator, equipment, accommodations, social, government, communication and "additional", with the idea that these themes are a suitable can be a starting point for communicating the various risks in dashboards

We are looking for a graduate who

1. wants to verify with various stakeholders whether these themes indeed cover the desired information needs and offer a suitable division (and if not, come up with an adapted proposal),
2. based on data collected within Sportkeur analyzes which information needs can already be met and where to start, and
3. prepares a design with appropriate visualizations for the different theme maps and validates this with stakeholders. In the project there have already been run-ups and focus groups with stakeholders, but these were more focused on the information need in a broad sense, and not specifically focused on the risk theme'. The aim of this graduation project is an inventory among stakeholders, verification of the risk themes, and design of dashboard concepts.

TASK DESCRIPTION

- Collect information needs from different stakeholders (proposed focus: sports federations, sports clubs and athletes)
- Verifying the risk themes with these stakeholders as a starting point for the provision of information
- Determining how and to what extent the desired information needs can be met from the information currently collected in the system (and advice for possible expansion)
- Design dashboard concepts for a selection of the identified risk themes and validate them with the stakeholders
