1. The SLTS (Saxion Living Technology Scholarships)

The Saxion Living Technology scholarship is for excellent and very talented students from outside the European Economic Area (EEA) that participate in **technical bachelor and master programmes**. The scholarship grants a deduction on the total package fee of €10.000,-.

2. The SHTTS (Saxion Holland Top Talent Scholarship)

This scholarship is meant for excellent and very talented students from outside the European Economic Area (EEA) who want to follow their bachelor's or master's degree in the Netherlands. The scholarship grant covers the institutional tuition fee, with the exception of the statutory tuition fee. The statutory tuition fee is adjusted every academic year.
